to be issued by the city of Green Bay, under chapter one hundred and fifty-one of the general laws of 1861, bearing interest at eight per cent. per annum: provided, that the same have been or shall be issued for the purpose of taking up and canceling the old "plank road bonds" of said city, bearing eight per cent. interest per annum, are hereby declared to be lawful and binding, as if chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the general laws of the year 1862 had not been enacted.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 22, general laws 1868, providing for the expenditure of the drainage fund in the town of Cold Spring, in Jefferson county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-two of the general laws repeal of 1868, providing for the expenditure of the drainage fund in the town of Cold Spring, in Jefferson county, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage.
