

CHAPTER 9.

[Published March 5, 1866.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 322 of general laws of 1865, entitled "an act to authorize the city of Beloit to raise money, by wards, for the payment of bounties to volunteers for military service of the United States, and to provide for the levy and collection of the same."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and twenty-two of ^{Repeal.} the general laws of 1865, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 10.

[Published March 5, 1866.]

AN ACT to repeal section 6 of chapter 385 of the private and local [general] laws of 1865, entitled "an act to incorporate the Davenport lead-mining and smelting company."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section six of chapter 385 of the private ^{Repeal.} and local [general] laws of 1865, entitled "an act to incorporate the Davenport lead-mining and smelting company," (*be and the same*) is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
