town treasurer of the town, or the treasurer of the board, alderman, village or city, against him therefor. SECTION 9. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this bill [act,] are hereby repealed. SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to amend section 8 of chapter 111 of the revised statutes, entitled "of divorce."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section eight of chapter one hundred SECTION 1. Voluntary separation for five ears, cause for and eleven of the revised statutes, is hereby amended. as follows : by adding after the sixth cause for divorce. the following, as an additional cause for divorce, to wit : "7th. Whenever the husband and wife shall have voluntarily lived entirely separate for the space of five years next preceding application for divorce, the same may be granted on the petition of either party."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
