CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT relative to the duties of lumber inspectors, and amendatory of chapter 167 of the general laws of 1864.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section eight of chapter 167 of the gen-Accounts of logs; eral laws of 1864, is hereby amended, by adding at the end thereof the following, to wit: "And it shall be the duty of each lumber inspector to require of his deputy or deputies, at the end of each month, a true and correct account of all logs, lumber or timber surveyed or measured by him or them during the month next preceding, and immediately to enter such account upon the books of his office."

SECTION 2. Section eleven of said chapter 167 is when marks to hereby amended, by striking out next after the word inspector. "inspector," where it first occurs in said section, the. words, "between the first day of November and the

first day of March, in each year."

Section 8. Section twelve of said chapter 167 is Effect of the filthereby amended, by adding next after the word "dis-liens, &c. trict," where it last occurs in said section, the following words, to wit: "And the filing and recording of all such instruments and papers, shall have the same force and effect as the recording of deeds and mortgages in the office of register of deeds."

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.
