Section 8. This act shall apply to all corporations created by or under the laws of this state, and any and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT to provide for the expenditures authorized by the resolutions therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Auditing of cers; tain accounts.

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and required to audit the accounts for expenditures under and in pursuance of the following resolutions of the senate and assembly, viz.: No. 10, S., relative to adjutant-general's report; No. 21, A., relative to adjutant-general's report; No. 72, A., relative to surgeon-general's report; No. 111, A., relative to diagrams of assembly chamber; No. 62, S., relative to diagrams of senate chamber.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, belonging to the general fund, a sum sufficient to pay the accounts authorized by this act to be audited.
