CHAPTER 96.

AN ACT to prescribe certain duties of county officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follous:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the treasurer of Duplicate reeach county, immediately upon the receipt of any money point for moneys by him as such tracement to make the line of any money point county by him as such treasurer, to make out and deliver to clerks of boards. the clerk of the board of supervisors a duplicate receipt for such money, and it shall be the duty of the said clerk to make out and deliver to the treasurer duplicate receipts of all moneys received by him, which duplicate receipts shall be filed by said officers in their respective offices: and no fees shall be allowed them for such services in addition to their prescribed salary.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 97.

[Published April 23, 1866.]

AN ACT relating to weights and measures, and amendatory of section 11 of chapter 58 of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 58 of the revised Weight of cranstatutes, is hereby amended, by adding to said section, and at the end thereof, the following: "and thirtyfive pounds for a bushel of cranberries."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
