AN ACT to amend chapter 525 of the general laws of 1865, entitled "an act to regulate the mode of repairing mill-dams by joint owners."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 525 of the general laws of Applicable to booms and piers 1865 is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following: "The provisions of this act shall extend to booms and piers owned, used and occupied by two or more persons jointly, which have been heretofore or which shall be hereafter erected, and which are necessary for the enjoyment of the mills to which such booms and piers are appendages; and any party aggrieved shall have the same right to enforce the maintaining of such booms and piers, and the same remedies, and may be enforced in the same manner, that the repairing and maintaining of mill-dams are effected by virtue of this act."

SECTION 2.
