## GENERAL LAWS-CH. 164, 165.

## CHAPTER 164

## [Published April 20, 1867.]

AN ACT supplementary to chapter 53 of the general laws of 1858, entitled "an act for the formation and protection of county agricultural societies."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

List of officers to be filed with secretary of state. SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the secretary of . each county agricultural society organized in this state, immediately after the annual election of officers for such society, to file in the office of the secretary of state a list of the officers of such company [society,] giving the postoffice address of the president, secretary and treasurer of such society.

Prohibition.

SECTION 2. The state treasurer is hereby prohibited from paying the annual appropriation provided by chapter 53, laws of 1858, to any society, unless the receipt of the treasurer of such society is countersigned by the secretary of the society; and the secretary of state is prohibited from crediting the amount of such appropriation paid by the treasurer, unless the receipt thereof is countersigned by the secretary of the society, as hereinbefore provided.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
