

SECTION 4. So much of any law as specifies any other times for holding the general terms of the circuit court in said circuit than is by this act provided, is hereby repealed. Repealed.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 27.

[*Published March 20, 1867.*]

AN ACT to appropriate money to the governor for a certain purpose.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. For the purpose of paying such unavoidable and necessary expenses of the exhibition of the products of Wisconsin at the Paris universal exposition, to be held this present year, there is hereby placed at the disposal of the governor, to be used at his discretion, the sum of two thousand dollars, or so much thereof as he may deem necessary ; and this amount of two thousand dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state out of any money belonging to said fund not otherwise appropriated : *provided*, that no portion of the amount hereby appropriated shall be used or applied to pay the personal expenses of or any salary to any commissioner to said exposition. \$2,000 appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. revised.
