of parties to take depositions of witnesses after issue of fact joined in a case.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 73.

[Published April 3, 1867.]

AN ACT relating to the fees of registers of deeds for recording marriage certificates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The register of deeds of any county rees 25c. in this state shall receive the sum of twenty-five cents for registering any marriage pursuant to law, which shall be paid him on demand by the treasurer of the county in which such registry is made, in lieu of the fee of ten cents heretofore authorized to be paid for such service: provided, that such register shall have complied with the provisions of chapter 110 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the registration of marriages, births and deaths."

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening Repealed. the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be inforce from and after its passage and publication.
