GENERAL LAWS.

CHAPTER 1.

[Published January 25, 1968.]

AN ACT to provide for the purchase of two hundred copies of Webster's unabridged dictionary.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state superintendent of public in-May purchase struction is hereby authorized to purchase on behalf Webster's dictionary. of the state, two hundred copies of Webster's unabridged dictionary, at a cost not to exceed eight dollars per copy.

SECTION 2. Such dictionaries when obtained shall How distributbe distributed to the school districts of this state in ac-ed. cordance with the provisions of chapter sixteen and

chapter thirty-two of the general laws of 1867.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the How to be paid income of the school fund, a sum of money sufficient for. to pay for the dictionaries provided for in this act, and the state superintendent shall certify to the secretary of state the amount of such expenditure.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
