AN ACT to amend section three of chapter 484 of the general laws of 1864, entitled "an act to amend chapter 155 of the general laws of 1868, entitled 'an act to codify the laws of this state relating to common schools."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter 434 of the general laws of 1864, is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "Section 3. Section seventy eight of said chapter 155 is hereby amended so as to read: 'Whenever a school district shall be unable to obtain the school house site, or addition to such site, selected or designated by a majority of the electors thereof present at a regular meeting or at a special meeting called for that purpose, on account of the refusal of the owner to sell or lease the same for a just and reasonable compensation, or on account of the owner being a non-resident, such site may be located and established by the town board of supervisors in the manner hereinafter provided.'"

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
