

CHAPTER 2.

[Published January 25, 1868.]

AN ACT to repeal sections one and two of chapter 44, of the laws of 1866, entitled "an act to limit the number of officers and employees of the legislature."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

SECTION 1. Sections one and two of chapter 44 of the laws of 1866, (*an act*) entitled "an act to limit the number of officers and employees of the legislature" is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 3.

[Published January 25, 1868.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 37 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act to amend section one of chapter 364, of the general laws of 1865," entitled "an act for the encouragement and protection of the wool growing interests of this State."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

SECTION 1. Chapter 364 of the laws of 1865, entitled "an act for the encouragement and protection of the wool growing interest in this state," and all acts amendatory thereof, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
