CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT to amend section one of the general laws of 1867, entitled "of medical societies."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 95 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "of medical societies," is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows: "and that if any practicing physician or surgeon shall write or cause to be written, any prescription or recipe, in any characters, figures or cypher, other than in the English or Latin language, generally in use among medical practioners, he or she shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable for every such offence by a fine of a sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars and not less than five dollars."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to authorize the superintendent of public instruction to apportion school moneys to the towns of Caledonia and Mt. Pleasant, Racine county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Shall apportion school moneys.

SECTION 1. The state superintendent of public instruction is hereby authorized and directed to apportion to the towns of Caledonia and Mt. Pleasant, in the county of Racine, for the year 1868, such an amount of the income of the school fund as said towns would have been entitled to if joint district number twenty
