so far as the same may be furnished, and such other material as is contemplated in section six of chapter eighty of the revised statutes, shall be annually printed, published and distributed in like manner and number as provided in sections one and two of this act, on the order of the governor.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in

force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 75.

[Published March 10, 1868.]

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter 132 of the general laws of 1866, entitled "an act to vest the title of unredeemed lands in counties."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter 132 of the general laws of 1866, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 2. The county board of supervisors shall have full authority to sell and convey any and all such lands, and the certificates of tax sales to the county in such cases may be assigned, and tax deeds issued thereon, in accordance with the law now in force in such cases, and the proceeds therefrom shall be paid into the general or contingent fund of the county."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
