Secretary of state to issue warrant. he shall issue his warrant for the amount of mileage and the annual salary to which such member is entitled, directed to the state treasurer, whose duty it shall be to pay the same on presentation.

Appropriation.

SECTION 3. There is hereby annually appropriated a sum of money sufficient to pay the salary and mileage of members of the legislature as provided in this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 8.

[Published February 10, 1868.]

AN ACT relating to the fees of registers of deeds for recording marriage certificates.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fees for registering marriages.

SECTION 1. The register of deeds of any county in this state shall receive the sum of twenty-five cents for registering any marriage pursuant to law; which shall be paid him on demand by the treasurer of the county in which such registry is made, in lieu of the fee of ten cents heretofore authorized to be paid for such service: provided, that such register shall have complied with the provisions of chapter 110 of the revised statutes, entitled "of the registration of marriages, birth and deaths."

Proviso.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
