## CHAPTER 100.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT to provide payment to the chaplains of the legislature for 1869.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation to chaplains.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Rev. H. W. Spalding, out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, as payment in full for his services as chaplain of the senate during the present session. There is also hereby appropriated to each of the resident clergymen of Madison, who have officiated in the capacity of chaplain in the assembly during the present session, twenty-five dollars. And the secretary of state shall draw his warrant for such amounts upon presentation to him of a certificate from the speaker of the assembly, to the effect that the person named in such certificate has so officiated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force after its passage.
