## CHAPTER 165.

[Published March 28, 1869.]

AN ACT to repeal so much of the provisions of chapter 484 of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled "an act to incorporte the state fireman's association of Wisconsin, organized September 24, 1863, as exempts individual property from taxation."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repealed.

So much of the provisions of chapter Section 1. 484 of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled "an act to incorporate the state fireman's association of Wisconsin, organized September 24, 1863," as exempts the individual property of firemen from taxation, is hereby repealed, and no such exemptions shall hereafter be allowed: provided, however, the common council of any city and the trustees of any incorparated village in this state, in which there shall be a fire engine or engines owned by such city or incorporated village, shall annually appropriate or pay to each active fireman belonging to any fire or hook and ladder company, organized by authority of such city or incorporation, such sum as may be reasonable, as a compensation for the services of such firemen.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
