## CHAPTER 60.

[Published March 5, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and thirty three of the revised statutes, entitled "of costs and fees."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

constables fees Section 1. Constables may be allowed to receive the following fees: For each mile actually traveled, going and returning to serve any process, or to give or post up notices, ten cents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 61.

[Published March 5, 1869.]

AN ACT to prevent under theriffs and deputy sheriffs from holding the office of county supervisor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senats and assembly, do enact as follows:

Under sheriffs and deputies not to be elected county supervisors.

SECTION 1. No person holding the appointment of under sheriff or deputy sheriff in this state, shall at the same time hold the office of county supervisor, or by virtue of any other office act as a county supervisor, and any person holding the office of county supervisor in any county in this state, who shall accept the appointment of under sheriff or deputy sheriff, or shall act as such under sheriff or deputy sheriff, shall by so doing, be deemed to have resigned his office of county supervisor, and such office of county supervisor, and such office of county supervisor shall thereupon become vacant.
