CHAPTER 90.

[Published March 8, 1869.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter 175, general laws of 1865, pertaining to the St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and seventy-five Repealed. of the general laws of 1865, entitled "an act to confer upon the St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad all the rights and privileges granted and conferred to the state of Wisconsin by the acts of congress approved June 3, 1856, and May 5, 1864," is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 91.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 258, general laws of 1864, so as to authorize the county of Pierce to vote for aid for right of way to any railroad company which may locate a line of railroad therein.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 258, general Section 1 laws of 1864, is hereby amended as follows: after the amended word, "railroad" in the fifth line by adding thereto, "or on any line of railroad which may be located through the county of Pierce by any railroad company."

SECTION 2. Section two of said act is hereby section 3 amended after the word, "counties" in the fourth line amended.

by inserting, "and of Pierce county."
