AN ACT relating to the duty of the superintendent of public property.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

May furnish sta-

Section 1. The superintendent of public property is prison commiss hereby authorized and directed to give out all necessary stationery for the use of the office of the state prison commissioner, upon the order of the state prison commissioner or his deputy, and for the use of the office of superintendent of public property; and the said superintendent of public property shall open a separate account with the state prison commissioner and superintendent of public property, for all stationery so furnished, and in all reports required of him to be made, shall include the amount of stationery furnished in accordance with the provisions of this act, in the same manner as he is now required by law to keep accounts with and report amounts furnished for the use of the offices of other state officers.

> SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
