

## CHAPTER 33.

[Published March 14, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend section 37 of chapter 182 of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to establish a township system of school government."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and eighty-two of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to establish a township system of school government," is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the words following: no vote shall be taken upon the question of township school government in pursuance of this act, unless notice thereof shall be given as hereinafter provided. The town clerk of any town, upon the petition in writing of any ten electors of said town, shall publish by posting in three of the most public places in said town a notice in writing, that the question of township school government will be submitted to the electors of said town at the ensuing town meeting or fall election. Such notice shall be so published and posted, at least ten days before the holding of any such town meeting or fall election; and any town having adopted the township school government according to the provisions of this act, may abolish the same at any town meeting or spring election, or at any fall election in the same manner as provided for its adoption in this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
