

CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to amend chapter 6 of the revised statutes, entitled "of printing and publication."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Secretary of
state to sell laws
and documents.

SECTION 1. Section thirty-eight (38) of chapter six (6) of the revised statutes, entitled, "of the public printing," is hereby amended by adding to said section the following clause: "5. No law or document shall be distributed except as provided in this chapter or in the acts amendatory thereof; but the secretary of state is hereby authorized to sell to any person being a citizen of this state, a copy of each publication provided for in this chapter, at such price to be computed by the secretary of state as shall be equal to the cost of the same to the state. And it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to keep an accurate account of each and every sale, and to pay the amount realized from such sales, quarterly, into the state treasury; and he shall include in his annual report a statement showing the number of volumes sold, and the amount received therefor."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
