ed by adding at the end thereof the following, to wit: "provided, that in counties where the system of county highways is in force, the county shall be liable for injuries sustained on roads that have been adopted by the counties."

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 47.

[Published March 11, 1872.]

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the payment of indebtedness, current expenses and repairs, and for permanent improvements and the purchase of furniture and live stock at the Hospital for the Insane at Madison, for the year 1872.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any Appropriated, money in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eighty-seven thousand and two hundred dollars in full for the following purposes, at the Hospital for the Insane at Madison, for the year 1872, viz: for current expenses and ordinary repairs, sixty-three thousand and four hundred dollars; for special repairs to building and heating apparatus, and for furniture, seven thousand and one hundred dollars; for payment of real estate contracted for, eleven thousand dollars; to purchase improved live stock, two thousand dollars; for permanent improvements, three thousand and five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. All sums for current expenses and re-How often pairs shall be drawn from the treasury not oftener than drawn. quarterly in advance.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication, and shall be printed in the volume of general laws for 1872.
