

the company may remove their property and provide for a new connection. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding thirty days, or by fine not exceeding one hundred dollars, and shall be liable in a civil action to such company, and to any person or corporation for all damages occasioned by said violation.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 55.

[*Published March 19, 1872.*]

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and forty of the general laws of 1864, entitled "an act to amend chapter one hundred and eighty-seven of the general laws of 1859, entitled an act to amend section twenty-one of the revised statutes, entitled of the school and university lands."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and forty of the general laws of 1864 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "All sales at auction of school, university and swamp lands and all other state lands, shall be made at such time and at such such public places as the commissioners of school and university lands shall designate. and the commissioners shall, previously to any such sale, cause a notice thereof, specifying the time when and the place where the same will be held, to be published once in each week, for at least six successive weeks, in one newspaper, printed in the county where such lands are situated, if any; but if there be no such newspaper, then in the newspaper printed nearest to the place where such lands are located."

Shall give notice of time and place of sale.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
