in the same year, on the inhabitants of the district; and the taxes so assessed by an overseer shall be collected and expended in like manner as highway taxes assessed by the supervisors are required to be collected and expended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to provide for the removal of the naturalization papers on file in the municipal court of the city of Watertown, to the office of the clerk of the circuit court of the county of Jefferson.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The clerk of the circuit court of the May transfer county of Jefferson is hereby authorized and empow-maturalization ered to apply for and receive all the naturalization papers, declarations or other documents and records pertaining to the naturalization of foreigners now in the office or place of custody of the records and papers of the late municipal court of the city of Watertown, and preserve them in some secure place in his office; and the clerk of the circuit court aforesaid shall be deemed the proper custodian of such papers and documents, the same as though they had been originally filed in his office.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
