CHAPTER 199.

AN ACT to reimburse Nelson Boutin, sheriff of Bayfield county, for expenses paid and incurred by him in suppressing a riot and keeping the peace in Ashland county, attached to Bayfield county for judicial purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Nel-Appropriated. son Boutin, sheriff of Bayfield county, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifteen hundred and twenty-seven dollars, for the purpose of reimbursing the said Boutin for expenses paid and incurred by him in suppressing a riot and keeping the peace in Ashland county in January, A. D. 1878.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-one of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes, entitled "of counties and county officers," and acts amendatory thereto.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifty-one of chapter thirteen of Amended. the revised statutes, entitled "of counties and county officers," as amended by chapter one hundred and sixty-three of the general laws of 1871, entitled "an act authorizing the publication of the lists of lots and lands on which taxes for the year 1870 are unpaid, in certain counties, in a newspaper printed in the German language," is hereby amended by inserting after the words, "any other than the English language," where they last occur, and before the word, "provided," the words, "to be designated by such county board of su-
