

death of another, he shall be guilty of manslaughter, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished according to the provisions of the section of the criminal statute defining that crime.

SECTION 6. That any and all contracts made in violation of the provisions of this act are hereby declared to be void, and the vendor may return the oil, fluid or substance purchased, at the expense of the vendor, and recover from the vendor all that he had paid therefor, including all charges for transportation and all other damages resulting directly from said sale. Contracts in violation of this act to be void.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May next.

CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Stevens Point relating to license for selling intoxicating liquors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision first of section three of sub-chapter four of chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the private and local laws of 1858, entitled an act to incorporate the city of Stevens Point, is hereby amended by striking out and repealing all of said subdivision first, after the word, "provided," in the eleventh line, as printed in the laws of 1858, and inserting the following: "That the sum to be paid for any such retail license shall not be less than one hundred nor more than three hundred dollars, and that no license shall be granted for less than one year." Amended—what amount to be paid for licenses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
