CHAPTER 63.

AN ACT to repeal chapter thirty-six of the private and local laws of 1870, relative to the protection of fish in the waters of Fox Lake, in the town of Fox Lake, in the county of Dodge, and state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter thirty-six of the private and local laws of 1870 is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 64.

AN ACT to amend sections thirteen and fourteen, chapter five hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1865, entitled, "an act to dispose of the swamp and overflowed lands, and the proceeds therefrom."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section thirteen of chapter five hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1865 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Each county treasurer receiving a sum of more than five hundred dollars, before receiving the moneys directed to be paid to him in the next preceding section of this act, or any part thereof, shall execute to the chairman of the county board of supervisors of said county, a bond, with two or more sureties, to be approved by the said chairman by endorsement over his official signature on
