Kewaunee, on the first Monday of February, and on the second Monday of July, of each year.

SECTION 2. Nothing in this act contained shall affect the existing law authorizing the holding of the term of the circuit court in Sheboygan county on the third Monday of February, 1874, but the said term shall be held as now provided by law.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 120.

[Published March 7, 1874]

AN ACT to prescribe the time for holding the terms of the circuit court for the counties of Dunn and Pepin in the Eighth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Circuit court terms in Dunn and Pepin connties.

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court in the following named counties shall be held at the times hereinafter mentioned, to wit: In the county of Dunn on the second Monday of March, and the second Monday of September in each year. In the county of Pepin on the third Monday of April, and the third Monday of October in each year.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with or contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of July, 1874.
