

CHAPTER 14.

[Published February 7, 1874.]

AN ACT to authorize the county judge of the county of Green Lake, to hold special terms of the county court at the city of Berlin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Judge of county court authorized to keep office, and hold special terms in city of Berlin.

SECTION 1. The judge of the county court of the county of Green Lake is hereby authorized to keep his office and to hold special terms of said court at the city of Berlin, in said county, at his discretion, between the times for holding the regular terms in each month, and all business done and transacted, and all judgments, orders and decrees made by said judge or court at such special terms, or at his office in the city of Berlin shall be as lawful, binding and valid in all respects, as if done, transacted and made at the regular terms of the county seat of said county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication, and shall be published immediately.

 CHAPTER 15.

[Published February 10, 1874,]

AN ACT to authorize the city of Stevens Point to subscribe for stock in the Stevens Point Boom Company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to issue ten thousand dollars in bonds, and establish a sinking fund.

SECTION 1. The city of Stevens Point, in the county of Portage, is hereby authorized to subscribe to the stock of the Stevens Point Boom Company, to an amount not exceeding the sum of ten thousand dollars, and to issue the bonds of said city to said company in payment therefor, and to levy upon the taxable property of said city, taxes to pay the interest as it accrues upon said bonds which the said city may issue, and to establish a sinking fund for the gradual and ultimate redemption of said bonds at maturity, and the
