

CHAPTER 149.

AN ACT to appropriate to Charles P. Marks, junior, the person therein named, a sum of money for land certificate No. 363 dated July 20, 1857.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, for land certificate No. 363, dated July 20, 1857, the sum of one hundred and seven dollars and fifty-one cents, in full, to Charles P. Marks, junior.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 150.

AN ACT to confer certain powers upon county clerks in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When county clerks may give a casting vote.

SECTION 1. Where any county board of supervisors is composed of but two persons, the county clerk shall have the casting vote whenever a tie vote occurs, and all questions so decided shall be legal and binding upon the part of the county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
