## CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT to legalize the action of the board of supervisors of Barron county at the annual meeting for 1873, fixing the salaries of county officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The proceedings of the board of super-Barron county visors of the county of Barron at the annual meeting of Barron county for 1873, fixing the salaries of the district attorney, clerk of the court and county judge, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid for all purposes as though the said board had fixed the said salaries at their annual meeting in the year 1872.
