## CHAPTER 261.

AN ACT to amend chapter 446 of the private and local laws of 1868, entitled an act to incorporate the Wisconsin Railroad Farm Mortgage Land Company.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter 446 of the private and local laws of 1868, entitled an act to incorporate the Wisconsin Railroad Farm Mortgage Land Company, is hereby amended by adding to said section the following: *provided*, said commissioners shall make a dividend of not less than five per cent, to be applied and paid to the persons entitled to receive the same as aforesaid, on or before the first day of July next.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 262.

[Published March 24, 1874.]

AN ACT to improve Nail creek, in Chippewa county.

The people of the state of Wisconsn, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Who may improve river. SECTION 1. For the purpose of improving that branch of Chippewa river known as Nail creek, so as to facilitate and insure the driving and floating of logs and timber down and out of said creek, it is hereby provided and enacted: That any person, association, company or corporation, their successors or assigns, that shall have improved said Nail creek by erecting dams for the purpose of flooding and creating reservoirs
