

CHAPTER 346.

[Published March 17, 1874.]

AN ACT to provide for the auditing of the claim of Stevens, Sorenson and Company, for damages claimed to have been sustained in the building of the Northern Hospital for the Insane.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Trustees of Northern Hospital for Insane to examine claim of Stevens, Sorenson & Co.

To certify to secretary of state the amount due.

Secretary of state to draw warrant.

SECTION 1. The trustees of the Northern Hospital for the Insane are hereby authorized to examine the claim of Stevens, Sorenson and Company, in relation to the building of the Northern Hospital for the Insane, and whatever sum they determine on as being justly due the said Stevens, Sorenson and Company, they shall so certify to the secretary of state, who shall draw a warrant on the state treasurer for the amount so found in favor of the Stevens, Sorenson and Company.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 347.

[Published March 21, 1874.]

AN ACT to regulate insurance companies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

When amount written in policy to be deemed the true value of property and measure of damages.

SECTION 1. That in all cases where any individual or insurance company or companies, authorized by laws of this state to take risks and issue policies of insurance against fires, and transact the business of insurance in this state, whether incorporated by this or any other state, shall insure or issue a policy of insurance against loss by fire, upon the real property of any individual or incorporation in this state, and the property so insured shall be wholly destroyed, without criminal fault on the part of the assured, the amount of insurance written in said policy or policies shall be
