Penalty for violating this law.

SECTION 2. If any insurance company, association or corporation, organized under any laws, other than those of the state of Wisconsin, shall violate any of the provisions of this act, their license to do business in this state shall be forfeited: provided, that no such forfeiture shall take place, for any violations of the provisions of this act, within sixty days after this act shall go in effect.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 61.

[Published February 28, 1874.]

AN ACT to authorize the city of Racine to regulate and license hawkers and peddlers within the limits of said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

City council authorized to license hawkers and peddlers. SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Racine are hereby authorized and shall have power to establish rates for, and license and regulate the traffic of all hawkers and peddlers endeavoring to procure the sale of goods and wares by traveling from house to house, within the limits of said city, and may pass appropriate ordinances, rules or by-laws to carry the provisions of this act into effect, and may provide suitable penalties for the violation thereof, consistent with the powers granted said city council by the charter of said city.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
