JOINT RESOLUTIONS.

No. 1.

JOINT RESOLUTION in relation to the purchase of supplies and employment of labor by state officers and officers of state institutions.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That it is the duty of the state government, as far as practicable, to care for, protect and promote the interest of its own citizens; and that all state officers and all officers of state institutions are hereby instructed in all cases to give preference to citizens of the state of Wisconsin in the purchase of supplies or the employment of labor for the state, or state institutions, whenever such supplies and labor can be obtained within the state upon as favorable terms as elsewhere.

JOINT RESOLUTION instructing our senators and representatives in congress to procure the passage of a law reducing the pay of civil and military officers.

Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring. That our senators in congress are instructed, and our representatives there requested, to procure the passage of a law reducing the pay of all civil and military officers of the general government to an amount that shall conform to the duties and labors performed.
