

## CHAPTER 114.

[Published March 8, 1875.]

AN ACT to legalize the acts of the board of aldermen of the city of Manitowoc in ordering street work, and to legalize the acts of certain officers relating to said street.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Acts legalized. SECTION 1. The order of the board of aldermen of said city in ordering Fifteenth (15) street in said city graded, is hereby legalized and made of as full force and virtue as if the said order had corresponded fully with the requirements and provisions of section six (6), of section three (3), of chapter three hundred and fifty-nine (359), of the private and local laws of 1871, and the same is hereby declared to be of as full force and virtue as if the same had adopted the language of said section fully, and (as) of as much force, as if the ayes and noes had been recorded in its passage.

Acts of street commissioner and other officers legalized.

SECTION 2. The action of the street commissioner, city treasurer, city clerk, and surveyor, acting under and by virtue of the above mentioned order, are hereby declared to be legal and in full force and effect, and shall not be void on account of irregularities which may have occurred.

Tax to be entered and collected.

SECTION 3. The proper authorities of said city of Manitowoc are hereby authorized to enter the tax levied for improving said street, or lots abutting on same, in the next annual tax-roll, and to proceed to collect the same according to law.

Records.

SECTION 4. The order referred to in section one (1) of this act is recorded in volume three (3) of city records, page two hundred and eighty-two (282), and is in the records of the minutes of the meeting of the board of aldermen of said city, on the third (3) day of August, A. D. 1874.

SECTION 5. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
