CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of the joint meeting of the assessors of the towns of New Holstein, Russell, Calumet, and Marshfield.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Acts logalized Section 1. The equalization of property in joint school district number three, of the town of New Holstein, county of Calumet, made on the seventh day of November, 1874, by the assessors of the towns of New Holstein, county of Calumet, Russell, county of Sheboygan, and Calumet and Marshfield, county of Fond du Lac, is hereby legalized and declared to be of full force and effect.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 133.

[Published, March 5, 1875.]

AN ACT in relation to building a boom or booms at the bridge across the Wisconsin River at Boscobel.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Required to Section 1. The city of Boscobel shall only be repaid but one quired to build one boom on the Wisconsin River at Boscobel bridge, said boom to extend from the north pier of said bridge to the north bank of the river, and to be not less than one hundred and twenty feet

When city Section 2. After the completion of said improvements at said bridge, and the permanent establishing of the river channel, then the said city shall build such boom or booms as prescribed by law, if deemed necessary by the engineer in charge of said improvements.
