Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 135.

[Published March 5, 1875.]

AN ACT to enable the cities of Green Bay and Fort Howard and the villages of Depere and West Depere, Brown county, Wisconsin, to expend their proportions of the county highway tax, on county highways in the limits of said cities and villages.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Highway tax
—how to be expended.

SECTION 1. All county highway tax now levied or that may hereafter be levied by the board of supervisors of Brown county, on the taxable property of the cities of Green Bay and Fort Howard, the villages of Depere and West Depere, in said Brown county, shall be expended under the direction of the common councils of said cities, in said cities, and the board of trustees of said villages, in said villages, on the public highways within the corporate limits of either said cities or said villages; provided, that such highways connect with the county highways leading into said cities and villages.

Repealed.

Section 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with section one, of this act, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
