

CHAPTER 149.

[Published March 9, 1875.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and nineteen (119), of the general laws of 1874, entitled, "An act to amend chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127), of the general laws of 1871, entitled, 'An act to fix the time of holding the terms of the circuit court in the fourth judicial circuit.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one (1), of said chapter one hundred and nineteen (119), is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section one (1), of said chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127), is hereby amended so as to read as follows: In the county of Fond du Lac, on the first Monday of January, on the fourth Monday of April, and on the first Monday of October of each year. In the county of Sheboygan on the fourth Monday of May and on the fourth Monday of November of each year. In the county of Calumet on the second Monday of June and on the second Monday of November of each year. In the county of Manitowoc on the fourth Tuesday of June and on the second Tuesday of December of each year. In the county of Kewaunee on the first Monday of February and on the second Monday of July of each year.

Amended.

Time fixed for holding terms of circuit court.

SECTION 2. All writs, services, proceedings and recognizance heretofore issued, commenced, made or entered into in or from said court of said county of Manitowoc, and all proceedings pending therein, or returnable thereto, whether by recognizance or otherwise, shall be held and taken as returnable at the time mentioned in this act for holding the said terms of court in said county.

Writs, &c., to be held returnable at times above set.

SECTION 3. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
