

CHAPTER 159.

[Published March 9, 1875.]

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society a certain sum of money.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society the sum of two thousand dollars out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Superintendent of public property to furnish stationery. SECTION 2. The superintendent of public property is hereby authorized to furnish the office of the Wisconsin State Agricultural society with stationery upon the order of the secretary of said society, the same as other officers in the capital are supplied.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Milwaukee Orphan Association, of Milwaukee, one thousand dollars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Milwaukee Orphan Association, of Milwaukee, for food and clothing for orphan children, the sum of one thousand dollars out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
