

CHAPTER 18.

[Published February 20, 1875.]

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Henry Voltquart as Notary Public.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All and singular the acts and doings of Henry Voltquart, of the town of Green Bush, Sheboygan county, as Notary Public, since December 6, 1874, at which date his commission expired, are hereby declared legal and valid and shall have the same effect in law as though his said commission had remained in full force at the time of doing or performing said act or acts. Acts legal-
ized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 19.

[Published February 20, 1875.]

AN ACT to authorize poison to be used for the destruction of wolves and wild cats in the months of November and December, in each year.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. For the destruction of wolves and wild-cats, it shall be lawful for any person, or persons, to put out baits containing poison, at suitable places, at not less distance than 80 rods from any dwelling house. from the tenth day of November to the twentieth day of December, in each year. Lawful to put
out poison.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons, having so put out baits containing poison, for the destruction of wolves and wild cats, shall, immediately after having put out such baits containing poison, post up, or cause to be posted up, notices, in three of the most public places in the town wherein such poison has by him been put out. Said notice shall contain a Precautions
to be taken.
