revised statutes of this state, shall apply to and be in force and effect in the con-truction and enforcement of said orders, rules, regulations and enactments.

SECTION 5. Justices of the peace shall have juris- Justices of the diction to hear, try and determine all costs [cases] jurisdiction. which may arise under the provisions of said orders, rules, regulations or enactments; provided, that the defendant shall not be deprived of a jury trial, nor the right of appeal as in other cases triable in justice's court.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to authorize the county treasurer of Winnebago county to certify the amount of indebtedness of the several towns and cities in said county to the clerks thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county treasurer of Winnebago County treasurer county, in this state, is hereby directed to certify to indebtedness of each clerk of the several towns and cities in said town and cities. county the amount of indebtedness due, if any, from such towns and cities at the time of the annual meeting in November in each year, and that the same shall be a part of the county tax against such town or city for that year, and shall be levied and collected as other taxes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
