AN ACT to amend an act entitled, "An act to amend section ten, of chapter one hundred and thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes of 1858, relating to verdicts and exceptions."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section one, of chapter one hundred Amending and ninety-four, of the laws of 1874, is hereby chap. 194, laws amended so as to read as follows: Section ten, of chapter one hundred and thirty-two, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: A general verdict is one by which the jury pronounce General vergenerally upon all or any of the issues, either in favor diet defined. of the plaintiff or defendant. A special verdict is special verthat by which the jury find the facts only, leaving dick the judgment to the court. In all civil cases the court shall, at the request of any party, direct the jury to find a special verdict. Provided, That such request be made at the close of the testimony and before any argument to the jury. Such special verdict shall be in writing, and shall be filed with the clerk and entered upon the minutes.
