AN ACT to amend section 5, of chapter 103, of the general laws of 1872, entitled "An act authorizing the formation of town insurance companies," approved March 23, 1872, and the act amendatory thereto, approved March 17, 1873.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

To pay per-centage in cash.

SECTION 1. Section (5), of chapter one hundred and three (103), of the general laws of eighteen hundred thereof, are hereby amended so as to read as follows: Persons in- "Section five (5). Every person so insured shall give and to give his undertaking, bearing even date with the solution issued to him, binding himself, his heirs and assigns, to pay his pro rata share to the company of all losses or damages by fire or lightning, which may be sustained by any member thereof; and every such undertaking shall, within ten days after the acceptance by the said company of said undertaking, be filed in the office of the secretary of such company, and shall remain on file in such office except when required to be produced in court as evidence. He shall also at the time of effecting such insurance, pay such percentage in cash, and such reasonable sums for a policy as may be required by the rules or by-laws of the company."

This act shall take effect and be in SECTION 2. force from and after its passage and publication.
