

CHAPTER 289.

[Published March 24, 1875.]

AN ACT to authorize the city of Milwaukee to refund the amount of a certain assessment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Milwaukee are hereby authorized to refund the whole or any portion of the amount of the assessment made by the board of public works in eighteen hundred and seventy-three (1873), against lots and parts of lots for a brick sewer on Pierce street in the eighth ward of said city, to any or all persons who have paid heretofore or may hereafter pay into the city treasury any amount for or on account of said assessment or tax; *provided*, that no amount shall be refunded to the owner of any lot which was not assessed prior to eighteen hundred and seventy-three (1873), for a brick sewer on said Pierce street.

Assessment refunded.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. Any sum so refunded shall be charged to the fund of the south sewerage district of said city.

How sum refunded to be charged.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 290.

AN ACT to amend section one, of chapter fifty, of the general laws of 1859, entitled, "An act in relation to the payment of state tax in the counties of Douglas and LaPointe."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter fifty, of the general laws of 1859, entitled, "An act in relation to the payment of state tax in the counties of Douglas and LaPointe" is hereby amended by striking out the word LaPointe where the same occurs in said section, and by adding after the word Douglas, where it oc-

curs in the first line in said section, the words "Polk, Bayfield and Ashland" so that said section as amended will read as follows: Section 1. The counties of Douglas, Polk, Bayfield and Ashland shall not incur the penalty provided by law for non-payment of state taxes at the time required by law; *provided*, the said counties shall pay to the state Treasury the amount due from them, respectively, on or before the second Monday of July in each and every year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication thereof.

CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT to amend section two, of chapter twenty-two of the general laws of 1871, an act entitled, "An act to fix the terms of circuit and county courts in the county of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Terms of cir. of

ca.t court. (22), of the general laws of 1871, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The terms of the county court of Milwaukee county shall be held on the first Monday of February, the second Monday of March, the second Monday of May, the first Monday of June, the first Monday of September, the first Monday of November, and the first Monday of December. No jury shall be summoned for either of said terms, except for those appointed to be held on the second Monday of March and on the first Monday of June, September and December.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
