AN ACT to legalize the action of the board of supervisors of Burnett county in letting the building of the court house in said

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

legal-Section 1. The proceedings of the board of super-Acts visors of the county of Burnett in letting the building of the court house in said county to the lowest bidder, in the month of January, 1875, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid for all purposes as though they had in all respects complied with the law in respect to such proceedings.

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

CHAPTER 302.

AN ACT to establish a ferry across Lake St. Croix, in section 27, in township 30, range 20.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. John H. Magney, his associates, heirs Authority to maintain ferry. and assigns, shall have the exclusive right and privilege for the period of ten years of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the St. Croix Lake in section twenty-seven (27), in township thirty (30), north of range number twenty (20) west, in St. Croix county, to the opposite shore in the state of Minnesota.
