and state of Wisconsin, at a school district meeting held in said district on the 21st day of September, 1874, are hereby declared legal and valid, and the officers elected thereat are hereby declared to be the legal officers thereof, anything to the contrary notwithstanding, and all acts of the officers elected at said meeting above mentioned shall be held to be as legal and binding as though they had been elected at the regular annual meeting of said district.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to amend chapter 337, of the private and local laws of 1871, entitled, "An act to revise, consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Prescott, and the several acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending SECTION 1. Section four (4), of chapter three (3), ehap. 337, P.* is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following: "And the justices of the peace may hold their offices at any place in said city."

SECTION 2. Section one (1), of chapter ten (10), relating to the police justice, defining his powers and duties, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
