

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum therein named to Mrs. Caroline D. Pettit, widow of the late Milton H. Pettit, Lieutenant-Governor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Mrs. Caroline D. Pettit, widow of the late Milton H. Pettit, Lieutenant-Governor, the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the same being the undrawn residue of his salary for the year 1873. Appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT to appropriate to J. H. Waggoner and G. W. Peck each the sum of fifty dollars.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to J. H. Waggoner, the sum of fifty dollars, for services in opening the present session of the Senate; and to G. W. Peck the sum of fifty dollars, for services in opening the present session of the Assembly. Appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
